In 2013 Western Carolina finished the season winning 21 of 24 games, which including winning 16 consecutive SoCon games, to win the Regular Season tile by 4 games over CofC and Elon. The #1 seed Catamounts went just 1-2 in SoCon tournament while #3 seed Elon dropped their opening game of tourney 10-1 to host Furman before winning 5 strait including a 6-5 win over The Citadel in the championship game to earn the automatic bid.

The Southern Conference tournament moves back to Charleston, SC for 2014 after being in Greenville, SC the last 2 years. The format will also change as all 10 teams will make the trip to Charleston with the #1 and #2 seed earning a bye. The 8 other teams will be paired (#4/#9, #6/#7 and #3/#10, #5/#8) with the loses playing elimination game and the lowest seeded winners on first day will play the top 2 seeds on day two.

#1-Western Carolina (39-20 overall; 23-7 SoCon; 1st)

The Catamounts regular season title in 2013 was their first Southern Conference championship since 2007. However, after going 1-2 in conference tournament and finishing the season at 39-20 with RPI#50 the Catamounts were left out of the NCAA tourney. WCU returns the offense and pitching to take the next step.

WCU returns 7 of 9 position players including 2 preseason All-Americans senior SS Aaron Attaway (.363, 68 R, 97 H, 15 2B, 5 3B, 12 HR, 54 RBI) and junior 1B/LHP Jacob Hoyle (.310, 66 H, 16 2B, 11 HR, 52 RBI). Senior C Adam Martin (.286, 40 H, 10 2B, 8 HR, 36 RBI) is primed for big season after being named top prospect this summer in the Northwoods League. Also returning are junior 2B Bradley Strong (.295, 61 H, 11 2B, 4 3B, 3 HR, 28 RBI, 17-23 SB), senior DH/C Luke Gragg (.293, 39 H, 1 HR, 26 RBI), senior OF Cody Jones (.283, 54 H, 8 2B, 3 HR, 22 RBI) and senior OF Dykota Spiess (.260, 13 2B, 4 HR, 20 RBI).

The Catamounts have the best 1-2 starters in the league in the 6'-8" junior RHP Jeremy Null (9-2, 3.46, 14 GS, 91.0 IP, 109 K) and senior RHP Jordan Smith (7-3, 3.73, 15 GS, 94.0 IP, 70 K). Null and Smith will give WCU the chance to win any weekend series in 2014. Last years set up man junior RHP Tyler Powell (2-2, 2.82, 34 APP, 2 SV, 38.1 IP, 55 K) moves into the closers role for 2014 and was just named one of 50 relievers on the NCBWA initial "Stopper of the Year Award". Freshman LHP Bryan Sammons (Wilmington, NC/Hoggard HS) should play a big role in 2014 and may start the season in the rotation. Sophomores RHP Jonathan Waszak (0-1, 4.81, 32 APP, 33.2 IP) and LHP Alex Barr (2-0, 6.62, 13 APP, 17.2 IP, 19 K) are expected to play big roles in the bullpen. RHP TJ Fussell (Asheville, NC/Montreat) transferred to WCU for graduate school from Montreat and was granted a 6th year of eligibility after being injured most of his career.

Prediction-WCU heads into 2014 as favorite for two reasons........Jeremy Null and Jordan Smtih. Entering the season there is no other team that can match the Catamounts top 2 starters. There are some question marks though and the biggest question mark is who will step up and be the #3 starter? Their top 3 hitters Aaron Attaway, Jacob Hoyle and Adam Martin are also probably the best 3 together in the league. In the end the same thing that kept the 2013 team out of a regional could prevent the 2014 club from getting a bid if they do not win the tourney. In 2013 WCU only played 3 games vs top 50 RPI clubs going 0-3 and have only 3 games (vs Clemson, at Georgia Tech, at Clemson) vs teams that finished with RPI below 50 in 2013. That means that there could be very little margin for error in 2014.

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#2-The Citadel (35-25 overall; 18-12 SoCon; 4th)

Coach Jordan and the Bulldogs had two tough years with young ball clubs in 2011 (20-36 overall and 8-22 SoCon/11th) and 2012 (25-33 overall and 13-17 SoCon/8th). In 2013 the now sophomore and juniors finished the regular season in 4th place and got to the championship game undefeated before losing to Elon 6-5.

7 of 8 position players return who combined for 49 HRs in 2013. Senior OF Hughston Armstrong (.379, 85 H, 11 2B, 1 HR, 23 RBI, .447 OB%, 18-19 SB), senior 1B Calvin Orth (.316, 68 H, 10 2B, 7 HR, 33 RBI), senior OF Tyler Griffin (.314, 50 H, 12 HR, 52 RBI), junior SS Johnathan Stokes (.309, 73 H, 13 2B, 5 HR, 25 RBI), junior 2B Mason Davis (.305, 62 R. 83 H, 11 2B, 5 HR, 25 RBI, 22-27 SB), junior DH Bo Thompson (.299, 58 H, 10 2B, 14 HR, 52 RBI) and senior OF/3B Drew DeKerlegand (.288, 61 H, 14 2B, 5 HR, 49 RBI).

The Bulldogs only lost one pitcher and return 27 of 35 wins. That one lost was Pitcher of the Year Austin Pritcher (8-3, 2.99, 99.1 IP, 80 K) but there is plenty left. Senior LHP Logan Cribb (4-3, 3.60, 11 GS, 75.0 IP, 64 K) should step into the Friday Night role and sophomore RHP Skylar Hunter (3-4, 5.35, 33 APP, 13 SV, 35.1 IP, 44 K) who was Louisville Slugger Freshman All American will return as closer. Two relievers had 88 appearances combined in 2013 senior RHP David Rivera (5-1, 4.03, 40 APP, 44.2 IP, 42 K) and senior RHP Zach Sherrill (3-1, 4.14, 48 APP, 45.2 IP, 38 K). The 48 appearances from Sherrill set Southern Conference record for most appearances in a season, the 40 appearances from Rivera are tied for 4th most ever. Also returning are junior LHP James Reeves (3-1, 4.01, 24 APP, 6 GS, 51.2 IP, 42 K), and sophomore RHP Austin Mason (3-4, 6.63, 13 GS, 54.1 IP)

Prediction-This is the season The Citadel has been waiting for since 2011 and the team should be rewarded for taking their lumps in 2011 and 2012. The offense should not have trouble scoring runs so the key to their season will be their pitching. After LHP, Logan Cribb there is not much experience starting. Sophomore closer Skylar Hunter has a great arm and saved 13 games as Freshman but needs to lower that 5.35 ERA. If the pitching staff comes through the Bulldogs will be hard to beat in 2014. Their schedule should allow them to be in position for an at-large bid.





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#3-Georgia Southern (27-32 overall; 13-17 SoCon; 7th)

Head Coach Rodney Hennon suffered his first losing season in his 16 seasons as a head coach and first time not winning 30+ games in season. GSU started 2013 by winning 2 of 3 from Georgia, winning at Flordia and splitting series vs Indiana and were (19-9 overall and 9-3 SoCon) after win at Jacksonville on April 2nd and finished the season (6-21 overall and 4-14 SoCon). The Eagles didnt pack it in and made a run to bracket finals undefeated before dropping 2 games to Elon. GSU brought in 21 new players in 2014 to turn it around quickly.

Leading the returning players are senior 3B/SS Ben Morgan (.307, 74 H, 16 2B, 6 HR, 36 RBI) and junior C Chase Griffin (.272, 65 H, 10 2B, 4 HR, 47 RBI). Also returning are seniors OF Robbie Dodds (.305, 65 H, 11 2B, 3 HR, 33 RBI) and UTL Stryker Brown (.252, 37 H, 1 HR, 16 RBI). Junior college transfer Dalton Busby (Bradenton, Fla/State College of Fla) should step in and play shortstop after having good summer in the Great Lakes league. Freshman Ryan Cleveland (HS Toccoa, Ga/Stephens Country) will start at first base.

The Eagles return 2 of 4 starters both left handers junior Sam Howard (6-7, 5.55, 11 GS, 84.1 IP, 87 K) and sophomore Jason Richman (4-5, 6.12, 14 GS, 72.0 IP). Howard will be Friday night guy with Juco transfer JR RHP Josh Wirsu (Harlem, Ga/Gordon State College) as the Saturday guy. Junior RHP Will Middour will likely start Sundayor mid week. Middour missed all of 2013 with injury after going 3-3, 3.60 ERA in 11 starts as sophomore in 2012. Sophomore LHP Evan Challenger (1-1, 4.23, 38.1 IP) threw well as freshman until injury cut his season short and should be able to throw around April. Freshman RHP Avery Fagan (HS Loganville, Ga/Loganville) has thrown the ball well since getting to Statesboro. One of top recruits freshman RHP Jordan Howard (HS Cordele, Ga/Crisp Academy) will miss all of 2013 with shoulder injury.

Prediction-The Eagles brought in a talented group of 21 players for 2014. The Eagles enter the season with some unknowns but will finish atleast in the upper half of league.





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#4-Appalachian St (30-24 overall; 13-14 SoCon; 5th)

The Mountaineers are taking a page out of Elon's normal scheduling book in 2014. They open the season with (3) at Arkansas, at Tennessee, (3) at NC State, and mid week game at UNC.

App St returns 6 of 8 position starters and gets back one of the leagues best in senior OF Tyler Zupcic. Zupcic (.338, 56 R, 71 H, 17 2B, 2 HR, 34 RBI) was all conference but missed the entire 2013 after injuring his knee in NCAA regional win over Oklahoma. Also returning are senior DH/3B Noah Holmes (.296, 9 2B, 5 HR, 27 RBI) and sophomore OF Jaylin Davis (.257, 53 H, 12 2B, 4 HR, 36 RBI) who was voted SoCon Freshman of Year by the coaches and a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American.

3 of 4 starters return on the mound led by JR RHP Jamie Nunn (9-5, 3.96, 15 GS, 97.2 IP, 77 K) who was 1st team all conference. Two lefthanders who both started 11 games last year are also back senior Chad Farmer (2-0, 5.40, 11 GS, 41.2 IP) and junior Jeffrey Springs (3-4, 6.28, 11 GS, 53.0 IP, 47 K).
