CBD MID-MAJOR MID-SEASON REPORT

Several mid-major clubs have had a great first half of the 2014 season. The clear #1 and one of best overall teams in the country is **Louisiana-Lafayette (30-3)** whos 30 wins are 3 more than anyone else in the country. The Cajuns swept 3 games at Southern Miss, won 2 of 3 vs Alabama, 1-0 vs LSU, won 2 of 3 vs **#23 Western Kentucky (18-15)** and just this weekend swept Sun Belt series at Troy.....**#3 UNLV (22-9)** has picked up several nice series wins 2-1 vs SDSU; and 3 road series wins 2-1 at 2-1 Neb; 2-1 at Fresno St and 2-1 at New Mexico......Preseason favorite **#6 Indiana (17-10)** started off slow, playing one of best early season schedules in the country(1-3 Texas Tech; 1-0 Wash; 0-1 Oreg St; 2-0 Lousville; 1-0 Kentucky; 0-1 Indiana St). The Hoosiers are starting to put it together with the start of B10 play......**#7 Liberty (25-8)** has had a very good first half and are 3 games up after winning 2 of 3 vs 2nd place **#22 Campbell (22-11)** in the North Division of the Big South. With Coastal Carolina (14-19) having a rare down year it looks like its the Flames and Camels. Liberty has a very good RPI of #18 however their best out of conference wins are 1-1 vs Old Dominion and 2-0 vs Duke. After seeing Campbell go 49-10 with a #42 RPI get left out in 2013 the Flames probably know they have little room for error....**#8 Dallas Baptist (23-8)** if off to a great start in their first year in the MVC. The Patriots are in 1st place at 5-1 ahead of **#11 Indiana St (21-7)** and **#18 Illinios St (19-10)** who both are 5-4 in MVC. Indiana St has a few nice wins in the first half 1-0 at Indiana, 2-0 vs Ohio St, 2-1 at UNCW, 1-0 vs Illinios St and just swept #21 Wichita St(16-14) in MVC play.....**#10 Western Carolina (20-9)** won 16 of 17 SoCon games to end 2013 and is in first place again at 8-1. One reason WCU got left out in 2013 was their lack of big wins, so far in 2014 key went 1-2 at Miss St, 2-0 at Washington St and 1-0 vs Clemson. Just behind the Catamounts is one of the best stories in college baseball so far in 2014,
