Western Carolina won their 2nd consecutive regular season title in 2014 but went 0-2 in the conference tourney to fall just short of NCAA berth for second year in a row. The surprise story of the regular season was Davidson College finishing their final season in the SoCon as #2 seed at 17-8 in SoCOn and 29-19 overall. #3 Seed Georgia Southern (15-12) and #4 Seed Samford (15-12) finished tied in the regular season and met in the finals. Samford won 3 straight to reach the finals and GSU took the much harder route. The Eagles opened the tourney with a 3-2 loss in 11 innings to App St before winning 4 elimination games including a 10-7 12 inning win over Furman to reach the finals. In the winner take all championship Samford held a 3-2 lead going to the bottom of the 9th before GSU pushed across 2 runs for the 4-3 walk off championship. The Eagles were sent to the Tallahassee Regional as the #4 seed and opened the regional upsetting #1 seed Florida State 7-0 behind a cg shutout from Jr LHP Sam Howard. GSU lost game two 13-5 to Kennessaw St and were eliminated by Alabama 6-0.

2015 WILL BE THE START OF A NEW ERA IN THE SOUTHERN CONFERENCE. IT WILL BE THE ONLY CONFERENCE IN THE COUNTRY TO NOT HAVE A TEAM THAT PLAYED IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT IN 2014. THAT IS SOMEWHAT FITTING FOR THE NEW LOOK LEAGUE AS THE SOCON HAS SENT 21 TEAMS TO THE NCAA TOURNEY SINCE 2003 AND 14 OF THOSE ARE NO LONGER IN THE CONFERENCE. WHILE THE LEAGUE WILL MORE THAN LIKELY BE A ONE BID LEAGUE THIS YEAR THAT DOES NOT MEAN IT LACKS TALENT OR GOOD TEAMS. THE TOP 3 TEAMS (SAMFORD, WCU AND MERCER) ARE A LITTLE AHEAD OF THE REST OF LEAGUE HEADING INTO THE SEASON AND ALL SHOULD BE IN THE REGIONAL DISCUSSIONS AT THE END OF THE SEASON. HOWEVER, IT WILL BE HARD FOR ANY TEAM TO KEEP THEIR NUMBERS HIGH ENOUGH TO GET IN. UNCCG COULD BE THE DARK HORSE, IN COACH LINK JARRETTS 3RD SEASON, AND CHALLENGE THE TOP 3. WHAT WE DO KNOW FOR SURE IS THAT WE CAN EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED IN THE SOCON.

The Mercer Bears enter their first season in the Southern Conference after finishing 2014 (38-17) overall and (18-9) 2nd place A-Sun. The Bears fell just short of a regional bid in 2014 however they had made the NCAA tourney in 2 of their previous 4 seasons (2010 and 2013). Since 2010 Mercer has not had less than 38 wins in any season and have averaged 39.2 wins per season.......Mercer returns just 2 starting position players, **Sr OF Nate Moorehouse** (.281, 34 h, 9 2b, 2 hr, 11 rbl) and **So C Charlie Madden** (.269, 36 h, 12 2b, 3 hr, 22 rbl). Returning players counted for 25% (131 of 523) hits and 24% (10 of 42) of HR's in 2014. **Jr C Tyler Homer** (Indian river CC) and **Fr OF Trey Truitt** (Dothan, Al/Rehoberth HS) should step in and produce in 2015........While Mercer lost most their offense they return most their pitching. Leading the staff is **Sr RHP Eric Nyouist** (8-1, 3.12, 13 gs, 4 cg, 86.2 ip, 49 k, .224 bl/avg) who was 1st team all conference in the A-Sun last year. Also returning from the weekend rotation last year is **Sr LHP Grant Papelian** (5-4, 4.13, 14 gs, 80.2 ip, 44 k). Redshirt **Sr RHP DJ Johnson** returns after being redshirted last year. Johnson's pitched and was the starting 2B his freshman and sophmore seasons before switching to full time pitcher in 2013 (5-1, 1.15, 16 app, 5 sv, 39.0 ip, 39 k), **Sr LHP Morgan Pitchan** (3-0, 1.30, 18 app, 4 sv, 27.2 ip) and **Sr RHP Ben Lumsden** (2-3, 2.16, 26 app, 6 sv, 33.1 ip, 31 k). **RHP Cartter Varga** (Clermont, FL/East Ridde HS) is newcomer that should have impact as a freshman.....Mercer lost a lot of offense but with the pitching they thave the pitching they have the prove the sound protecing of a clean of should finish in the top 3 or 4.

DH Bo Thompson (.315, 9 hr, 39 rbi 13th rd, NYY) and 2B Mason Davis (.310, 13 2b, 45 rbi, 27-33 sb 19th rd, MIA). **Freshman 1B Drew Ellis** (Columbia, SC/Blythewood, HS) is the top new comer for the Bulldogs and should be an impact bat......On the mound they return 43 of 58 starts, 19 of 25 wins and 403.1 ip of 507.0 ip. Leading the way is on of the best arms in the SoCon, **Jr RHP Skylar Hunter** (2-4, 1.67, 15 sv, 43.0 ip, 44 K) who has saved 28 games and averages 10.1 stikeouts per 9.0 ip. **R-Jr LHP James Reeves** (3-2, 3.40 era, 7 gs, 39.2 ip) returns after missing the second half of 2014 and has 12 career wins......If the Cadets want to finish back in the top half of the league they will need to pitch much better than they did in 2014 (last in team ERA 5.75) and have the arms to do so.
